God's System

It will not be so among you; but whoever wishes to be great among you must be your servant, and whoever wishes to be first among you must be your slave. -Matthew 20: 26-27

Matthew 20:16 So the last will be first, and the first will be last.

Matthew 20:25 But Jesus called them to him and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones are tyrants over them. 26 It will not be so among you; but whoever wishes to be great among you must be your servant, 27 and whoever wishes to be first among you must be your slave; 28 just as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many."

Matthew 23:11 The greatest among you will be your servant.

Mark 9:35 He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, "Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all."

Mark 10:42 So Jesus called them and said to them, "You know that among the Gentiles those whom they recognize as their rulers lord it over them, and their great ones are tyrants over them. 43 But it is not so among you; but whoever wishes to become great among you must be your servant, 44 and whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all. 45 For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many."

Luke 22:24 A dispute also arose among them as to which one of them was to be regarded as the greatest. **25** But he said to them, "The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them; and those in authority over them are called benefactors. **26** But not so with you; rather the greatest among you must become like the youngest, and the leader like one who serves. **27** For who is greater, the one who is at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one at the table? But I am among you as one who serves.

How might a circle, or sphere be a better image of God? Or- God's System?

Circles represent the notions of totality, wholeness, original perfection, the Self, the infinite, eternity, timelessness, all cyclic movement, ('God is a circle whose centre is everywhere and whose circumference is nowhere' (Hermes Trismegistus)). As the sun, it is masculine power; as the soul and as encircling waters, it is the feminine maternal principle. "It implies an idea of movement, and symbolizes the cycle of time, the perpetual motion of everything that moves, the planets' journey around the sun (the circle of the zodiac), the great rhythm of the universe. The circle is also zero in our system of numbering, and symbolizes potential, or the embryo. It has a magical value as a protective agent, ... and indicates the end of the process of individuation, of striving towards a psychic wholeness and self-realization" (Julien, 71).*

Circles are formed by joining all the points that are equidistant from one point, known as the center.

Orbits are circles, the Seasons are circular

Life and Death are circular

Crowns and halos are circles


Circles are a symbol of eternity and never-ending existence


The symbol for Trinity is a circle, God is a relationship of three persons in perfect harmony, complete, whole, perfect.
