e. Evangelism and Communication Board is looking at sharing outreach on being a welcoming inclusive church. Board also wishes to brainstorm about items for Foundation funding: St. John's Hall revamp to make it more welcoming (lighting, sound, and AV); donation to the KYMN Radio Tower; Community Evangelism/Outreach Event.
