

666	The number of the beast, Gematria: Nero Caesar (Nerōn Kaisar, Greek) = 666; Beast (Thērion, Greek) = 666; also the number of imperfection.
144,000	The innumerable saints in Heaven, not a literal number; the Bride of Christ.
Angels	God's messengers.
Apocalyptic	A literary genre that includes writings that often discuss the end of the world, cosmic destruction, and otherworldly experiences.
Apocryphal	A term that means "to hide away" and refers to writings of unknown authorship or questionable authenticity. Early Christian writers used the term to describe Jewish and Christian writings that were intended for an inner circle.
Babylon	The world system where the rich and powerful are privileged and rule with terror and violence, where the poor are trampled underfoot, and have no power to improve their lot and thrive.
Balaam	A false prophet from the book of Numbers. Tried to prophesy destruction of Israel, tried to corrupt Israel through sexual exploitation.
Beast/Wild Thing #1	From the Sea, "Anti-Christ," whose mission is to embody the will of the dragon. Represents chaos, power, deception, and opposition to the Lamb. Ruler of evil empires. One of the dead-heads of the wild thing is raised from the dead. It is worshiped by humans. Its rule is temporary. Makes up one third of the unholy trinity: dragon, wild thing #1 and #2.
Beast/Wild Thing #2	From Land, its mission is to embody the will of wild thing #1 and dragon. The sycophant in chief, the propagandist. Disguises itself like the Lamb, acts like the dragon. Forces worship of wild thing #1, does fraudulent miracles, deceives the world. Forces humans to accept the "mark of the wild thing." Its name is its number, 666. Represents chaos, deception, Roman Emperor Nero and many others.
Bowls of Incense	The prayers of the saints.
Crowned Heads	Represent world powers, domination
Dragon	The Devil, Satan, Serpent.
Eschatology	Study of end times.
Esoteric	Language intended for or likely to be understood by only a small number of people with a specialized knowledge or interest.
Four Horses	Deliverers of judgements.
Four Living Creatures	Signify every living created creature; Lion-wild beast, Ox-domesticated beast, Eagle-winged beast, and Man-human beast. All four act as one.
Horns (on heads)	Represent destructive power
Jezebel	Symbolic of Queen Jezebel, wife of King Ahab from Old Testament. Denotes violence, sexual exploitation, guilty of child sacrifice, evil.
Lampstands (7)	Signifying the 7 churches in Asia Minor, to be understood as the Church Universal.
Millenium	The time between Jesus' resurrection and his return.
New Jerusalem	The City of God in which God is dwelling on the Earth, after the final judgment.

Numerology: Four	4 represents The earth; at the time of writing it was generally thought that the earth was flat and had four corners.
Numerology: Seven	7 represents God's work on earth.
Numerology: Six	6 represents Mankind.
Numerology: Three	3 represents God.
Numerology: Twelve	12 represents complete and perfect; God's perfect government, power, and authority; the foundation of God's divine order; totality and completion of God's purpose.
Seven Spirits	The Holy Spirit.
The Lamb Who Was Slain	Risen Jesus Christ, Messiah.
The Throne	Only in Heaven, where God dwells.
Twenty-four Elders	Combination of Old Testament (12 tribes) and New Testament (12 apostles) believers.
Whore	Stands for: 1. the corrupt economic system, 2. worship of other gods, 3. sexual exploitation of innocents, temple prostitution, and pedophilia.
Witnesses	Martyrs, believers and followers of Jesus who suffer for their witness.
Woman	Morphs from Eve to Israel, to Mary (mother of Jesus), and finally to the church. She is opposed by the dragon, who tries to kill her and the baby boy born to her (Jesus). She escapes under protection from God. Her offspring is opposed by the dragon.
