Position Title: Finance Manager

Position Purpose

St. John's Lutheran Church is a Christian community committed to serving all ages in the midst of our diverse and changing society. Managing the church's expenses and income requires professionalism and sensitivity, not only to business integrity but also the sense of common ownership that members have in their church.

Job Description

Manage St. John's donations and accounts payable, provide accurate and timely financial information to church leadership, and assist with forecasting and strategy for managing St. John's cash flow and stewardship.

Primary Responsibilities

The Financial manager is responsible for:

- 1) Income and stewardship: Record pledges and gifts and provide regular acknowledgment of member stewardship and special gifts. Provide Senior Pastor, Treasurer and Stewardship Board with information relevant to planning church stewardship.
- 2) Accounts payable: Review, pay and record all vendor invoices; Manage church cash flow.
- 3) Administration: Administer church payroll and staff benefits program. Work with the Business Management Board to review insurance at least annually. Work with the Office Manager in providing for necessary church technology. Advise Personnel and Executive Committees on personnel salaries and expenses.
- 4) **Reporting:** In conjunction with the church Treasurer, provide monthly financial statements to the Church Council and annual report to the congregation. Provide information to the Audit Committee to complete quarterly audits.

Secondary Responsibilities

- 1) **Visioning and planning:** Work collaboratively with church staff in regular meetings; provide staff and church boards with financial information relevant to program planning.
- 2) **Forecasting:** Advise church leadership on manage church cash flow and investments; provide forecasts for future budgeting.
