Position Title: Director of Jubilate Choir

Person in This Position Reports to: Organist and Director of Music, Worship & Arts

Position Purpose

St. John's Lutheran Church is an ELCA congregation with over 150 years of ministry in the heart of Northfield, Minnesota. Our musical and liturgical tradition is known throughout the community. Wednesday afterschool programs supplement our ministry with children and youth 26 nights a year during the school year.

Job Description

The Director of Jubilate Choir is responsible for developing and directing the Jubilate Choir (children in 3rd-5th grades) with the goal of forming them in faith and involving them as participants and leaders in the worship of the congregation.

Primary Responsibilities

- 1) Lead the choir weekly rehearsals according to a schedule developed in cooperation with other music staff, as well as the children and youth staff.
 - a. Rehearsal time: Wednesdays afternoons September-May, except during scheduled school breaks.
- 2) Select music appropriate for the season of the church year and lectionary emphasis for the days when the choir is scheduled to sing in worship.

- 3) Prepare and direct the choir on Sunday mornings for worship services, usually once a month, on a schedule created with the music staff.
- 4) At the discretion of the director, rehearsal should involve participants in a variety of experiences, like singing, movement, games, listening activities, rhythm development, and instruments. We hope that rehearsals also include a basic introduction to liturgy, hymns, and the seasons of the church year.
- 5) Communicate the choir schedule with parents and recruit parents and other helpers needed to assist with the choir.

Secondary Responsibilities

- 1) Attend music staff meetings or full staff meetings as requested or available.
- 2) Coordinate with the Director of Music for necessary accompaniment.
