REVELATION 10

Meanwhile...

We turn from the terrible fifth trumpet's judgment, where the remainder of humanity that lives through the destruction of 1/3 of the earth has NOT had the hell scared out of them, but continue to worship demons and wealth, and remain unrepentant.

READ REVELATION 10:1-4

1. Use your imagination to watch this event unfold – If you were Steven Spielberg how would you picture this?

Possible symbolism of the Mighty Angel: clouds can represent judgments, rainbows can represent God's faithful covenants, a face like the Sun can represent holiness, one foot on land and one in the sea can represent the Universality of the message.

So, a Mighty angel shouting and seven thunders rolling, ... and someone in heaven says, " \mathbf{U}_{M} , never mind." Perhaps we have to assume things are going on in heaven that we can't be privy to.

READ REVELATION 10:5-7

2. What is the angel's message given in verses 6b-7? Perhaps the Seven Thunders is referring to the Mystery of God (v. 7)
