## REVELATION 13 THE WILD THINGS

We are now entering the wild part of Revelation. Remember, the book was written primarily for the followers of Jesus at the end of the first century. Our imaginations can run wild with the imagery, but we first need to understand what these visions meant to those who originally received them. A couple of things to remember: Babylon represents the systemic order of power created by the dragon and the wild things. It signifies the order of the world. When Jesus speaks of the world, he is not so concerned with personal piety; he refers to the worldly order of power, wealth, and corruption, the systems of government and rule that corrupt and empower the few at the top of the pyramid, along with the subsequent underlings who gain power and wealth by submitting to those at the top. I would venture to say that God is most concerned with the evils in a society that allow the rich to hoard wealth and trample on those who lack power and cannot participate in an honest, stable economy. We will discover that the dreaded "mark of the Beast" (66d) involves economic persecution.

IN CHAPTER 12 THE SEVEN HEADS OF THE DRAGON EACH BORE A CROWN (DIADEM) SYMBOLIZING WORLD DOMINATION, AND THE HORNS REPRESENT POWER. WE WILL NOW SEE THAT THE DRAGON STANDS BY THE SEA, SYMBOLIZING THE UNIVERSALITY OF THE WORLD'S NATIONS.

WILD THING #1 (BEAST FROM THE SEA) SYMBOLIZES THE OPPRESSIVE FORCE OF THE DRAGON (SATAN) FUNCTIONING THROUGH VARIOUS NATIONS AND GOVERNMENTS WORLDWIDE. #1 IS ALL ABOUT POWER, WHEREAS WILD THING #2 IS ALL ABOUT PROPAGANDA.
