## **REVELATION 9**

The fifth and sixth trumpet judgments (woes) reveal greater details than the scroll visions. Following the sixth woe will be an interlude, and we won't experience the seventh "Woe" until the middle of chapter II. In the middle of chapter 9, we are given the specific name of the one who has caused all this mess. The name is  $\Delta$  baddon (hebrew) and  $\Delta$  pollyon (Greek) translated as:  $S\Delta$ T $\Delta$ N.

"So the fifth angel blows the trumpet and a star fell out of heaven. This action has been confirmed by Luke 10:18, 'I watched Satan fall from heaven like a flash of lightning.' Again we see a critical event that takes place in heaven, where Satan, also known as the accuser, is thrown down to earth and no longer stands before God and shakes his finger in accusations against God's people."

**Sulfur -** The gas formed from burning **sulfur** can irritate the eyes, nose, and throat. It can also worsen asthma and other respiratory conditions. Sulfur can cause skin rashes, eczema, and allergic reactions. Ingesting large amounts of sulfur can lead to nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and constipation. High levels of sulfur in the blood can cause confusion, headaches, and seizures.

**Fires** - can produce toxic gases, smoke, and heat that can cause serious health issues. Smoke from fires can irritate the respiratory tract and lungs and can make it difficult to breathe. Fire ash can irritate the skin, nose, and throat. Contact with wet ash can cause chemical burns.

**Smoke** - can cause premature death, especially for children, pregnant women, and the elderly. Smoke can cause bronchitis, headaches, tiredness, and chest pain. Smoke contains tiny particles that can penetrate deep into the lungs, causing inflammation and irritation. Depending on what is burning, smoke can contain harmful chemicals like carbon monoxide, cyanide, and polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, which can be toxic when inhaled. Exposure to smoke can cause immediate symptoms like coughing, throat irritation, stinging eyes, and runny nose. Chronic exposure to smoke can contribute to respiratory diseases, heart problems, and potentially increased cancer risk.
